#### **VISA REQUIREMENTS**

Multiple – entry USA visa.

The cost of visa is not included in your package tour price. It would be best to check with nearest consulates or embassy or your travel agent for advice and information. Please ensure that your travel documents are ready in time before your tour date

- There is a possibility that your Tour Manager could change in-between the tour. Service of TM won't be provided if there are less than 20 Pax
- As a third person in a Triple room, no extra bed or cot will be provided. Instead a room with two queen beds will be provided.
- Internal flights would be via flights with one stop.

- All transfers and extensive sightseeing with entrance fees (as specified in the itinerary) by a deluxe airconditioned coach.
