

Day 1: Welcome to Copenhagen!

On arrival, our Tour Manager / Station Manager will meet and welcome you outside the airport. Later we proceed to the hotel and check-in. Overnight in Copenhagen, Denmark. (D)

Note: • Joining direct passenger / NRI can check-in on your own at the hotel • The Tour Manager shall meet the clients directly at the hotel • The standard check-in time is 1500 hrs • We may have to proceed directly for dinner or Packed dinner will be provided in case of late arrivals of flight or long queue at the immigration.

Day 2: Guided city tour of Copenhagen – Canal Cruise – Visit Carlsberg Brewery

Today, we proceed for a guided city tour of Copenhagen: See the Parliament building, Amalienborg Palace, Gefion fountain, Little Mermaid statue and many other interesting sights. Later, we enjoy a Canal Cruise. Later we visit the famous Carlsberg Brewery with beer tasting. Overnight in Copenhagen, Denmark. (**B**, LL, **D**)

Day 3: Fly to Bergen - Guided city tour of Bergen - Ride on the Funicular train

Today we check out and take a flight to Bergen. On arrival we proceed for a Guided city tour of Bergen: Visit the Hanseatic wharf Bryggen with its pastel – coloured wooden houses, winding cobblestone streets and old Bergen. Next, we take a ride on the Funicular train, to the top of the Mount Floyen for an aerial view of Bergen.

Overnight in Bergen, Norway. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Travel on one of Norway's most popular trips 'Norway in a nutshell'

Today, we drive from Bergen to Voss. On arrival we wander around the idyllic countryside. Next. we board our train from Voss to Myrdal. Later we take another train from Myrdal to Flam. We embark on a boat ride through the Aurlandsfjord into the Naeroyfjord, one of the narrowest fjords in Europe, surrounded by mountains of up to 1800 meters. On arrival at scenic Gudvangen, we board the coach and travel through the impressive Norwegian landscape to Oslo.

Overnight in Oslo, Norway. (B, LL, D)

Day 5: Guided Tour of Oslo – Entrance to Vigeland Sculpture Park – Entrance to Holmenkollen Ski Museum

Today, we proceed for a guided city tour of Oslo: See the Parliament Square, National Galleries, Karl Johan shopping street, the Royal Palace and Akhershus Fortress. Next, we visit Vigeland Sculpture Park. Later we visit the Holmenkollen Ski Museum: the world's oldest ski museum. Overnight in Oslo, Norway. (**B**, **L**, **D**)

Day 6: Fly to Tromso – Orientation tour of Tromso – Visit to Polaria Aquarium – Photo stop at Arctic Cathedral - Fjellheisen cable car

Today, we check out and fly to Tromso. On arrival, we proceed for an Orientation city tour of Tromso. Next, we take a photo stop at the Arctic Cathedral. Later, we visit the Polaria Aquarium: the world's most northerly aquarium. Later in the evening, we experience the Fjellheisen cable car where we get the panoramic views of Tromso & the fjords.

Overnight in Tromso, Norway. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Orientation City tour of Alta – Photo stop at the Cathedral of the Northern lights

Today we check out and drive on the Arctic route. On arrival at Alta, we proceed for an Orientation city tour of Alta. Next, we take a photo stop at the Cathedral of the Northern lights.

Overnight in Alta, Norway. (B, PL, LD)

Day 8: Midnight Sun tour from North Cape

Today, we drive to Honningsvag to venture through rugged arctic scenery on our way to the North Cape. On arrival we see endless ocean, majestic mountains and the Midnight Sun at the northernmost part of Europe. (Although we will do our best to ensure that you view the midnight sun, it is a natural phenomenon and is not guaranteed. The days of the Midnight Sun tour could also change based on the probability of viewing it).

Overnight in Honningsvag, Norway. (B, LL, LD)

Day 9: Visit the Sami Settlement

Today we checkout and proceed to Karasjok. Here we see the Sami Settlement and we experience the Sami Culture: Deeply rooted in nature, with traditions dating back to ancient times. We experience Reindeer feeding at the Sami Settlement.

Overnight in Kirkenes, Norway. (B, LL, LD)



Day 10: Visit the Snow hotel – King Crab Safari (OPTIONAL) – Experience the Husky Wagon

Today, we visit the Snow hotel which stands as a testament to innovation and adventure, offering an unforgettable experience which stands out for its cozy cabins and stunning views. Next, you have a chance to experience the King crab fishing adventure (OPTIONAL). Later we ride in a Husky Wagon.

Overnight in Kirkenes, Norway. (B, LL, LD)

Day 11: Fly to Helsinki – Visit Fazer experience

Today, we check out and fly to Helsinki. On arrival, visit Fazer experience centre and learn the art of chocolate making including chocolate tasting. Overnight in Helsinki, Finland. (**B**, **PL**, **D**)

Day 12: Guided city tour of Helsinki – Onto Tallinn

Today, we proceed on a guided city tour of Helsinki: See the Senate Square, visit Lutheran Tempelliauki Church, Sibelius Park and many more interesting sights. Later, we board a cruise to Tallinn. On arrival we check in to the hotel.

Overnight in Tallinn, Estonia. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Guided city tour of Tallinn

Today, we proceed for a guided city tour of Tallinn: See the Toompea Hill, Parliament building, Dome Church, St. Nicholas Church, Town Hall Square. Next, we see the Alexander Nevsky Cathedral. Later, we drive to the pier to board a overnight cruise to Stockholm.

Overnight in Silja line. (B, L, LD)

Day 14: Guided city tour of Stockholm – Visit Stockholm City Hall – Visit famous Vasa Museum – Visit Skyview Global Arena

Upon arrival at the pier, we proceed on a guided city tour of Stockholm: See the Opera House, Alfred Nobel's House and the Royal Palace. Also, we visit the Stockholm City Hall - the seat of Stockholm Municipality. Next, we visit Vasa Museum - Sweden's most visited museum enshrining the warship, Vasa. Later, we visit Skyview Global Arena. In the evening we spend some free time in Gamla Stan – the old Town.

Overnight in Stockholm, Sweden. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Fly back home with pleasant memories!

Today, we proceed to the airport for your flight back home. Kindly spare a few minutes to share your feedback with your Tour Manager. Your valued suggestions will be most appreciated. Arrive home with pleasant memories of your Europe tour, which we are sure you will treasure for a lifetime. (B)

VISA REQUIREMENTS

- Multiple entry Schengen Visa.
- You must be in possession of a Multiple Entry Schengen. The cost of visa is not included in your package tour price. It would be best to check with your travel agent and the consulates nearest to you for advice and information. Please ensure that your travel documents are ready in time for departure.

TICKETING REQUIREMENTS

 For this tour you would require confirmed air tickets to arrive into Copenhagen and depart from Stockholm. It would be advisable to check with your sales officer or local travel agent for ticketing.

WHAT YOUR TOUR PRICE INCLUDES

- Sightseeing and accommodation as per the above-mentioned itinerary.
- All transfers and extensive excursions with entrance fees (as specified in the itinerary) by a deluxe air-conditioned coach.
- Services of a professional, friendly and multilingual Tour Manager or a local Representative. (Subject to minimum 15 customers).

WHAT YOUR TOUR PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE

- Air tickets required to participate in this tour.
- Visa charges, Insurance, Airport & Port taxes.
- Tipping is expected from anyone providing your service e.g., Coach Driver, Local Guides, Hotel & Restaurant staff etc. It is mandatory to tip a nominal amount of EUR 3 per person/per day. For the entire duration of this tour, which is 15 Days, the total Tips amount is EUR 45 per person to be paid to the Tour Manager on Day 01 of the tour.
- No porterage included.
- Any expenses of a personal nature such as porterage, laundry expenses, wines, mineral water, food and drink not in the regular menu provided by us, minibar, telephone calls, etc.
- Meals other than that are mentioned in your itinerary.
- Cost of excursions, city sightseeing, entrance fees and local guides availed of by the passengers, other than that mentioned in your itinerary.
- Airport transfers, Cost of Suggested / Optional Excursions.

IMPORTANT NOTE

HOTELS

- All hotels will be either around the airport area or on the outskirts.
- The hotel room size in Europe would be up to 16 18 sq. mts.
- Most hotels in Europe have only Twin beds. The double bed will be Queen size and not King size.
- As a 3rd person in a triple room, most hotels use rollaway beds and room size may be the same as the double room.
- For Child with bed: At times hotel don't have enough roll away beds, in that case they might give a double and a separate single room.
- A person 11.99 years and below is considered a child and 12 years and above, an adult.
- Hotel rooms may not be air conditioned / air cooled nor will fans be provided. Air conditioning / cooling in hotels are set as per European weather conditions.
- Functioning of Air cooling / Air conditioning in hotels is subject to official declaration of summer by the local authority.
- During heat wave in Europe air conditioning of the hotels and coaches may cease to function as they are not built for such high temperatures.
- Most hotels in Europe do not provide tea kettles in the rooms.
- Due to international events and trade fairs all throughout Europe such as the Air Show, music festivals, ice skating championships etc., you may have to stay in hotels further away from the city.
- In Switzerland the stay may be split in two hotels.
- Any damage caused to the hotel rooms / Coach during your stay shall be payable by the passengers.
- We also reserve the right to substitute a hotel of similar class if it is deemed advisable or necessary.
- In certain cities hotels have not started the buffet breakfasts yet and if the same does not change by the time the tours begin, we will either provide breakfast or the groups will be taken to an Indian / local restaurant for breakfast.

COACHES

- Most of your journey in Europe is by coach and hence you are requested to keep the coach clean.
- Due to hygienic reasons, it is not permitted to use toilets on the coach. However, the tour manager will make comfort stops during long drives.
- · Eating & drinking is not permitted on the coach.
- One check-in bag and one handbag per person only, due to limited boot space on the coach.
- In major European cities, there are parking restrictions for coaches, and it may not be possible to stop at all the places during the city tour. Tour Manager will try his/her best to stop coach wherever possible for a photo stop.
- Coaches are non-wheelchair compliant. There are steps to board / alight from the coach.
- Due to private coaches being forbidden inside most of the European cities, as per EU norms to preserve them and to avoid getting them polluted and overcrowded, most of your sightseeing will be done by local buses and on foot.

MEALS

- Meals are pre-set and a-la carte is not possible.
- On certain days, a packed lunch will be provided.

SIGHTSEEING

• On certain departures, we may sometimes amend / reverse the itinerary. However, all the services / inclusions will remain the same.

- Generally, you will have to walk to sightseeing places, amusement parks and the airports sometimes for a long distance; however, the same will be timely instructed by the Tour Manager. It is advisable to carry a good pair of comfortable sports shoes. The tour manager and the driver will do their best to get you as close to the monuments as possible.
- The Eiffel Tower on certain Days due to strong wind conditions or being overcrowded or for security reasons may be closed.
- The lifts at the Eiffel tower are currently closed due to safety. Hence the visit to the tower is only allowed by climbing the staircase. In case there is no change in the same on tour customers will be refunded the amount for the same if they chose not to climb the stairs.
- Due to stringent security checks at the Eiffel tower, it may take up to 4-5 hours in the queue.
- No refund will be provided in case the group is unable to visit Eiffel Tower 3rd Level due to weather conditions / operational closures.

GENERAL

- On some occasions you may have to join another group in case the group does not have adequate members.
- A local representative or a driver may only be there to assist you during your initial part of the tour.
- Arrival and Departure flights should be booked according to the group flight timings. In case there is any sightseeing involved on the first or last day of the itinerary to avoid missing any of the services.
 Please check with your sales officer for the group flight timings.
- Security alerts and random closures might affect the itinerary.
- Please take extra care of your personal belongings while on the tour, every country you travel to is prone to thefts and bag snatching. TCIL will not be liable for any loss of belongings / baggage.
- Disabled clients should carry their own wheelchair and should be accompanied by a qualified companion who is able to provide assistance to the disabled client.
- TCIL shall not accept any liability or responsibility for any damages, loss, baggage loss, theft, injury, accident, death, breakdown or irregularity, which may occur in carrying out the tour arrangement, weather conditions, strikes, war, quarantine and any other cause whatsoever and all such loss or expense must be borne by the passengers. Insurance policies must be carried while on tour.
- The management reserves the right to claim any additional expenses incurred due to delays or changes in schedules of train, airplane, bus, ship or other services.
- The Tour Manager and the company reserves the right to amend the itinerary, alter, vary or withdraw any particular departure, excursion advertised. For the convenience of our passengers, we will sometimes amend the itinerary. However, all the services will remain the same.
- There are no refunds for any services i.e., meals, sightseeing etc. not utilized on your tour.
- All optional activities will have to be booked and paid to the Tour Manager on Day 01 of the tour. Payments to be made by cash in EURO only. (Credit or Debit cards not accepted).
- Optional tours are booked & paid on 100% non-refundable & non cancellation policy.
- GST will be applicable for all optional activities pre-paid in India.
